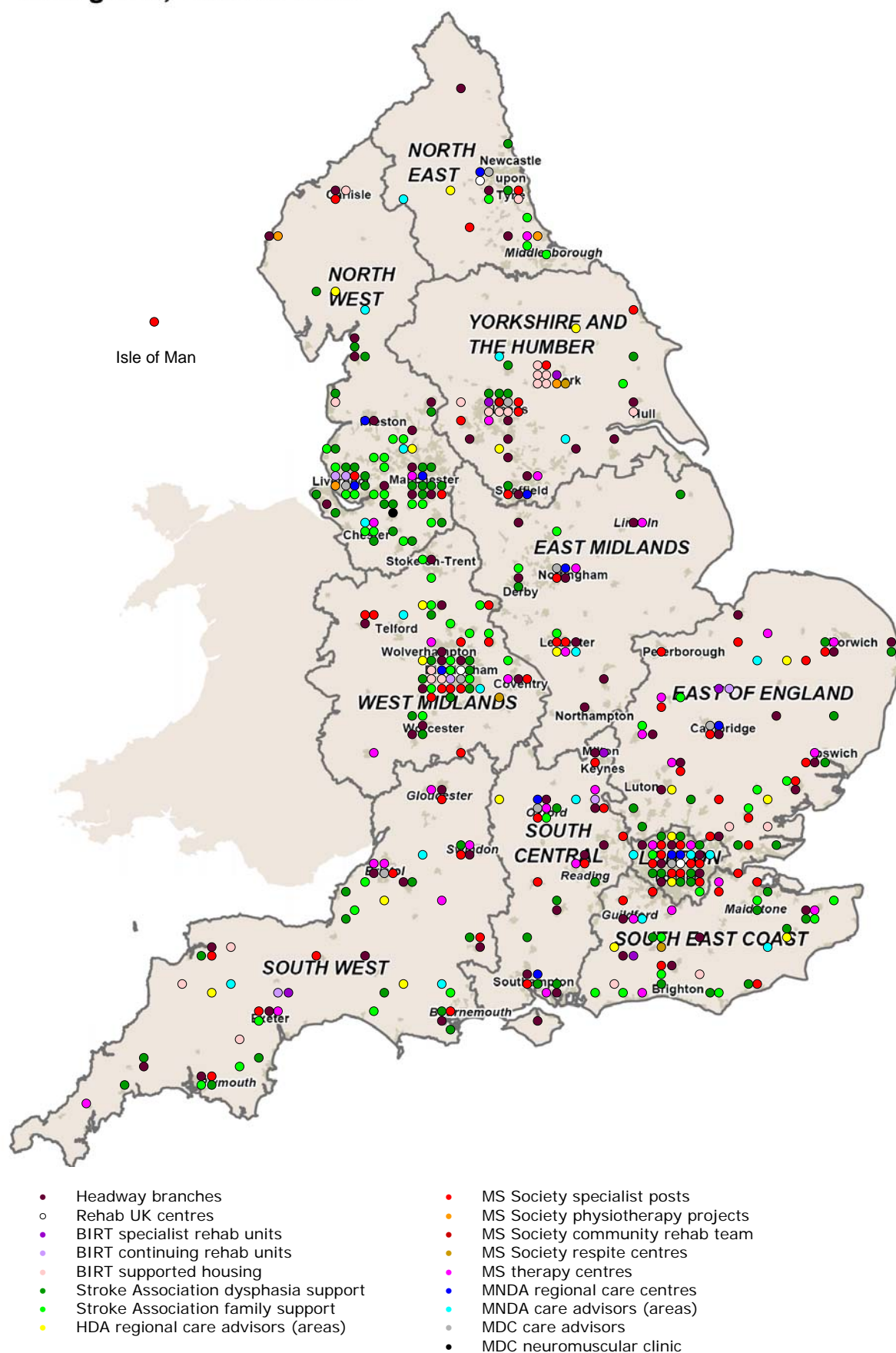

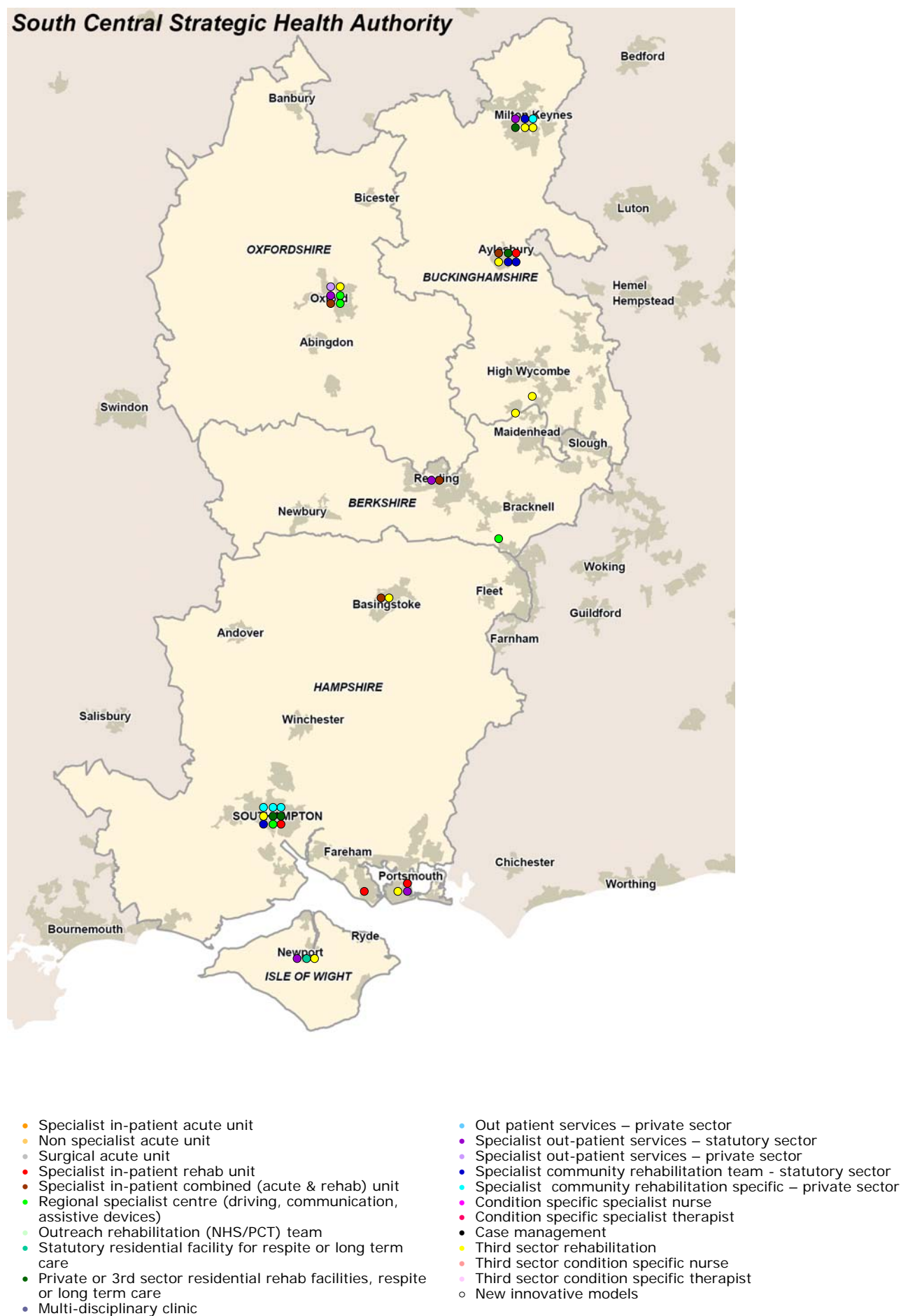

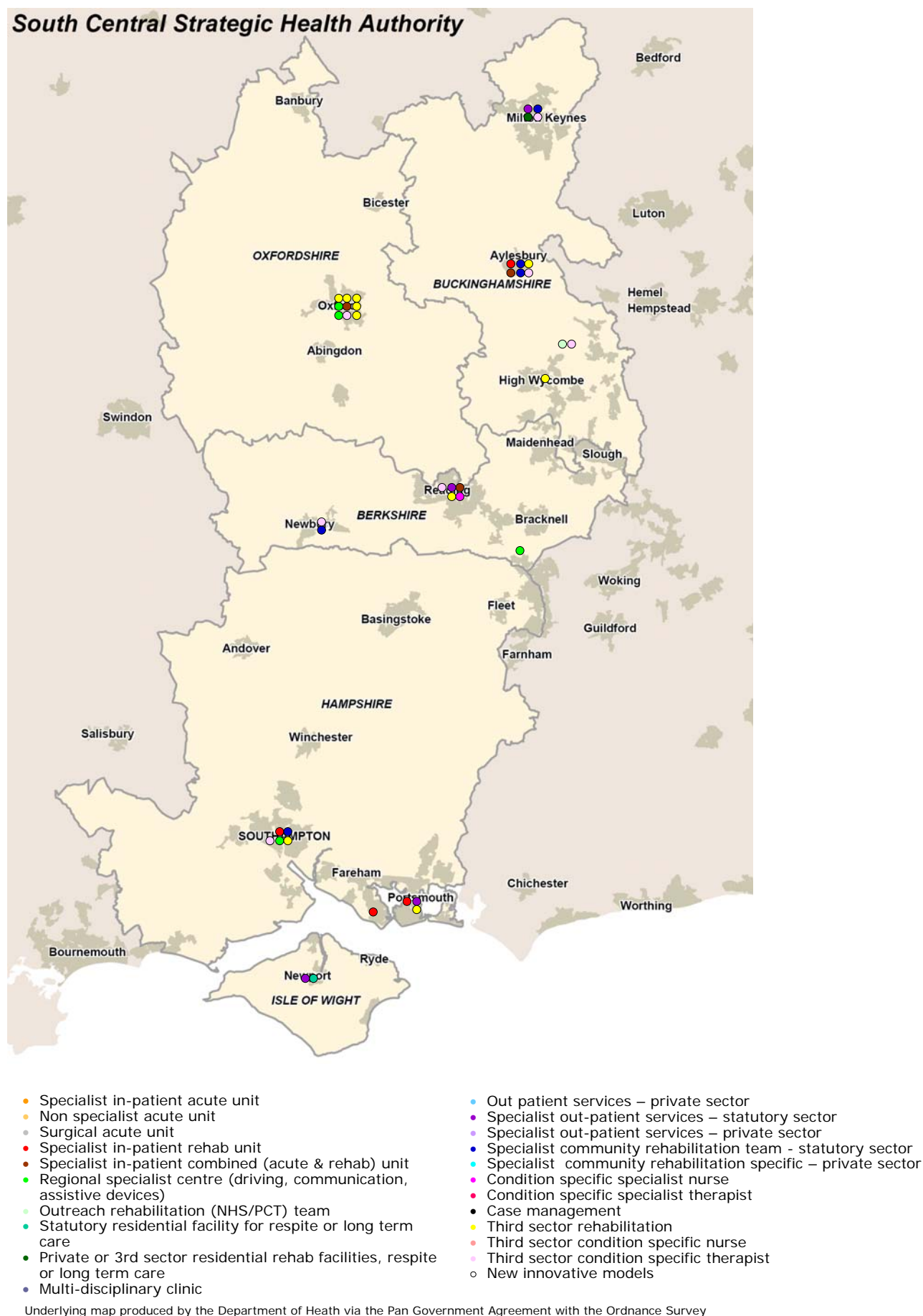


Map 5 Specialist services for people with stroke in South Central

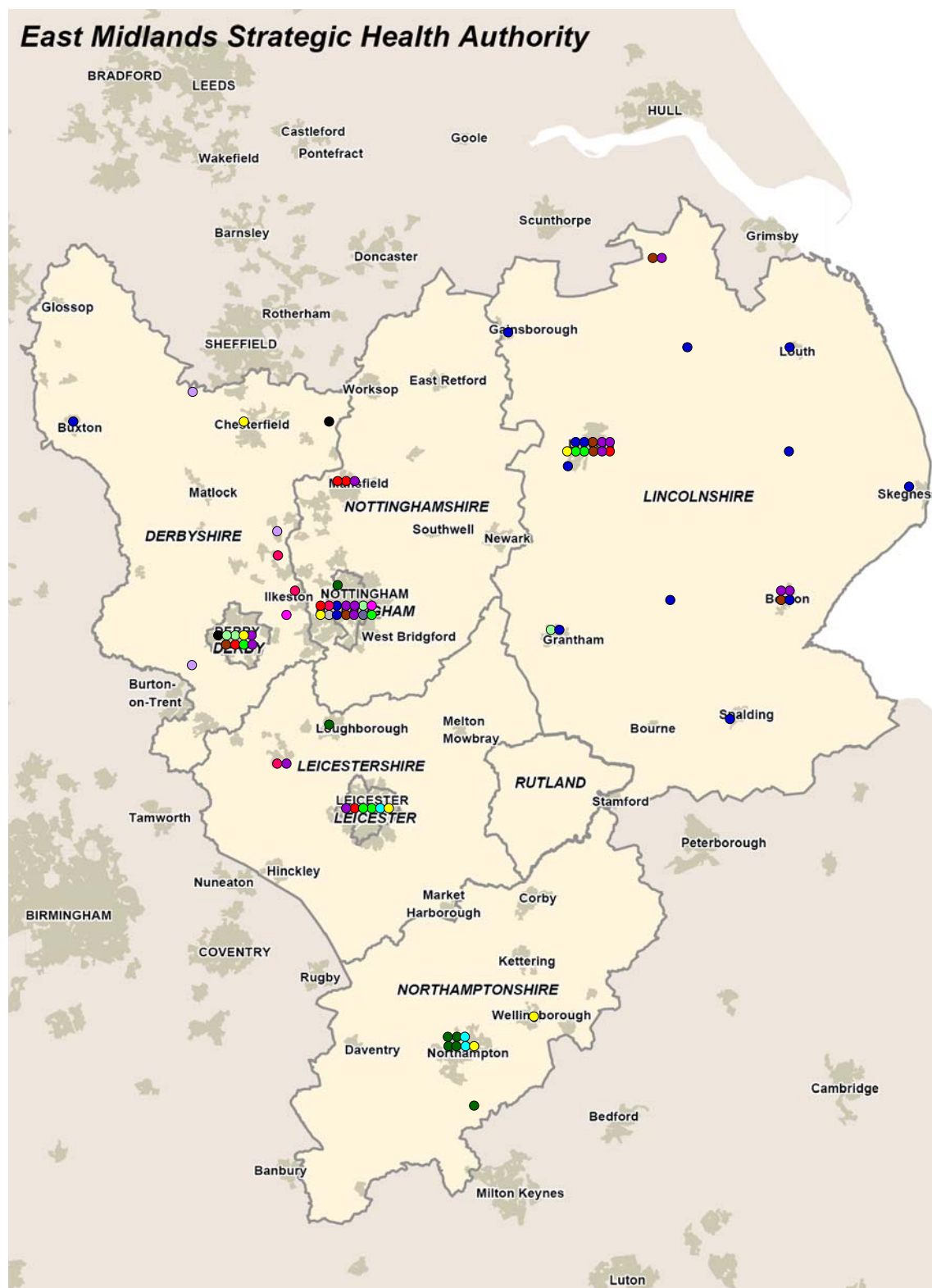

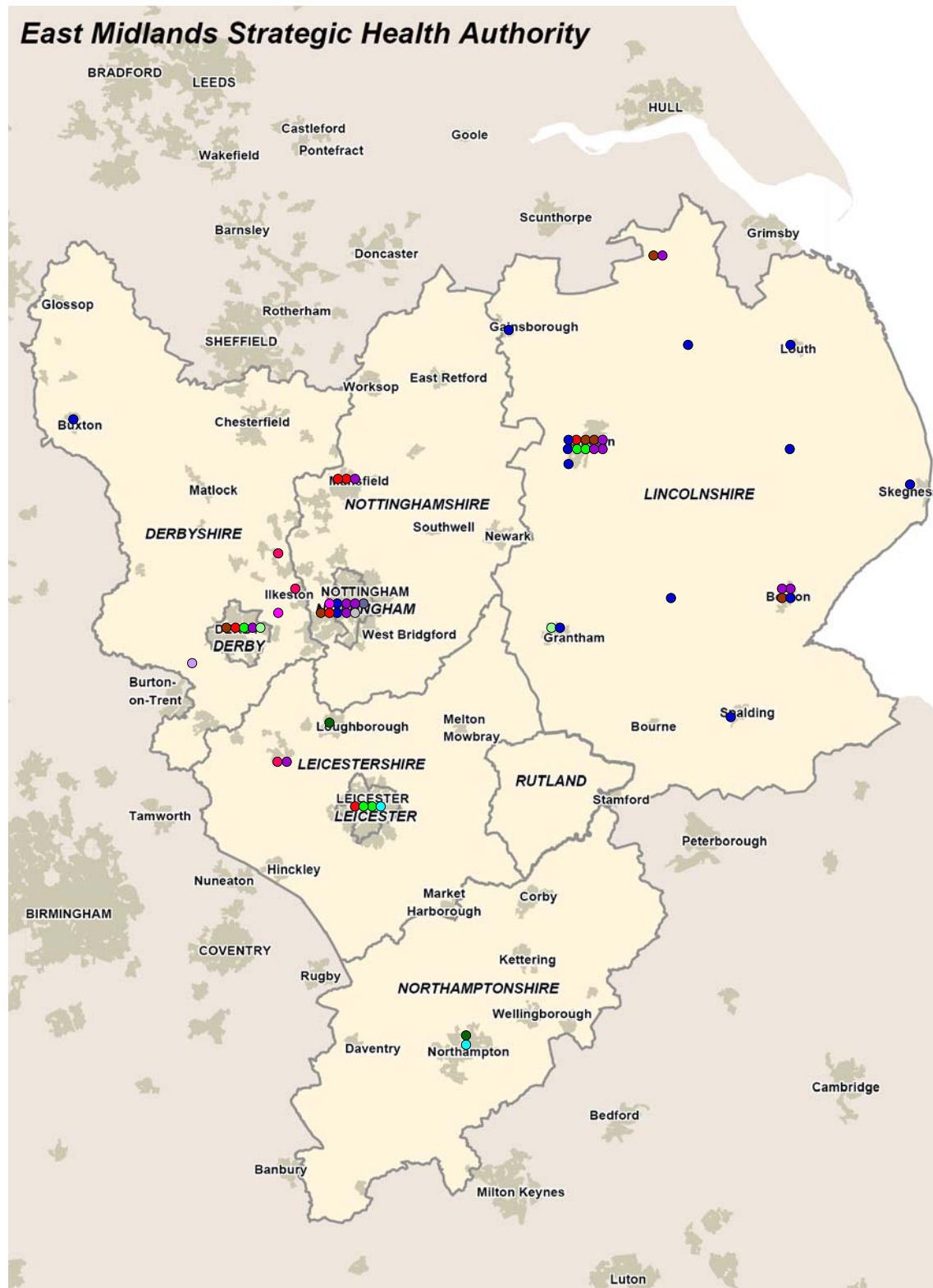

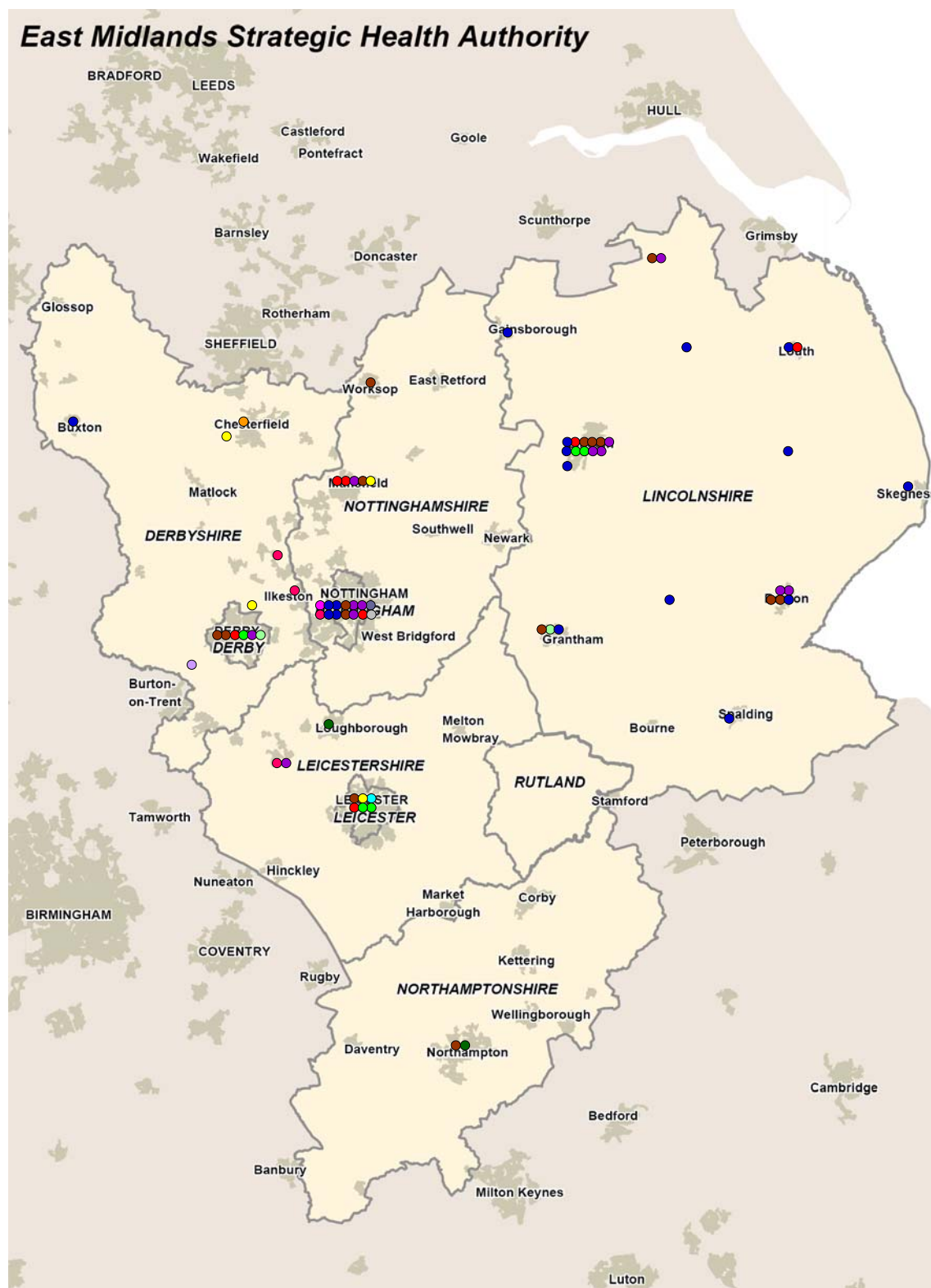

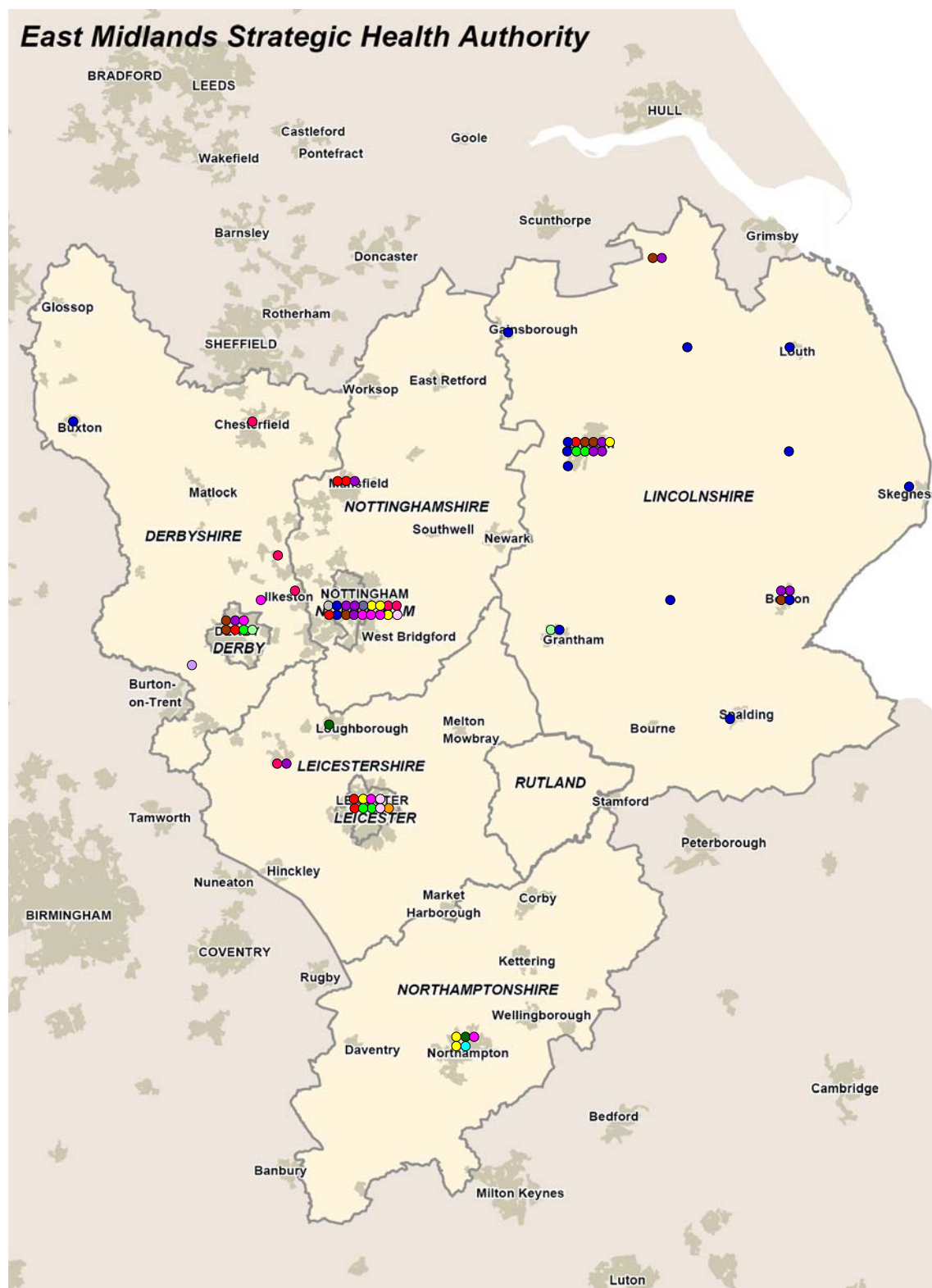

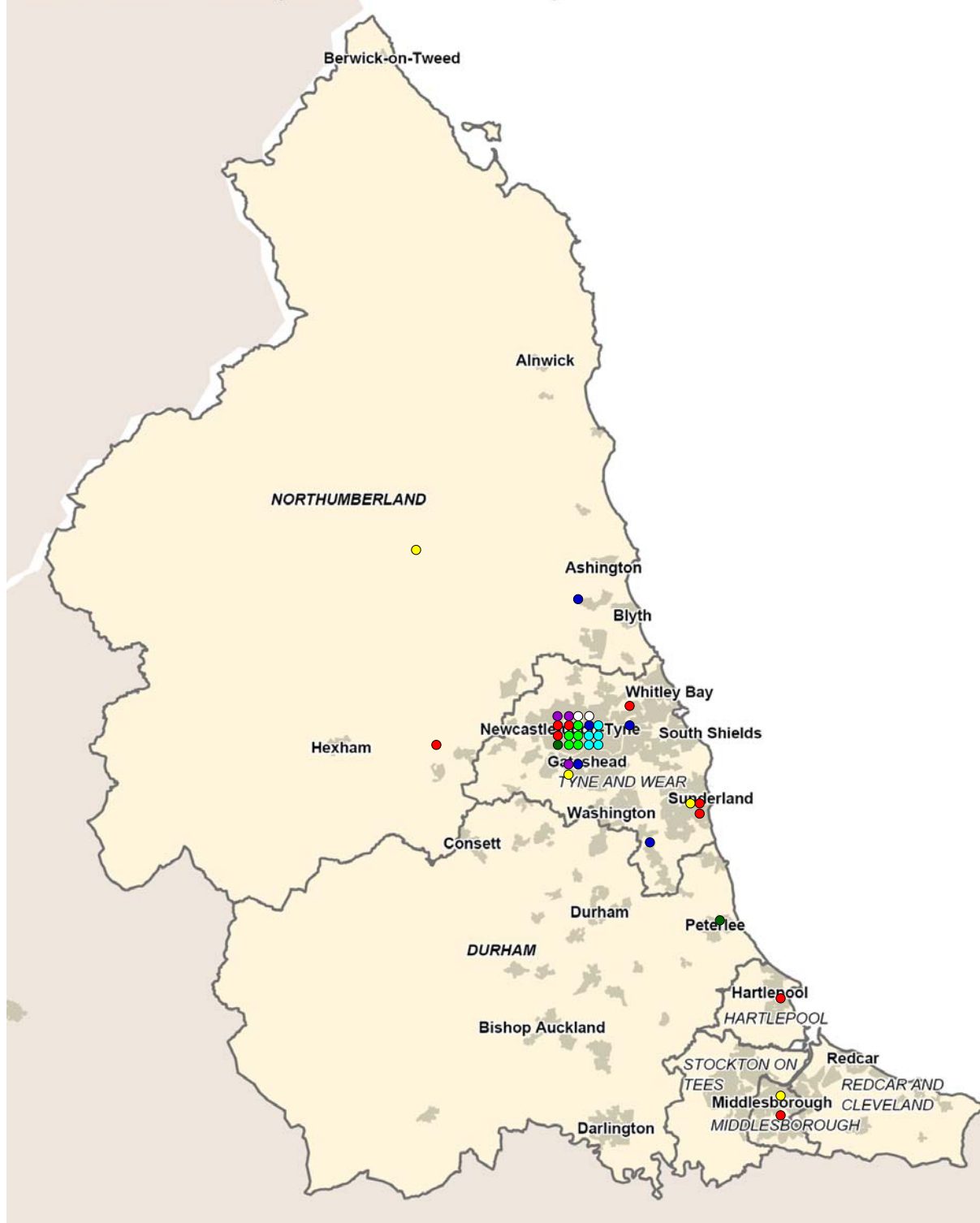

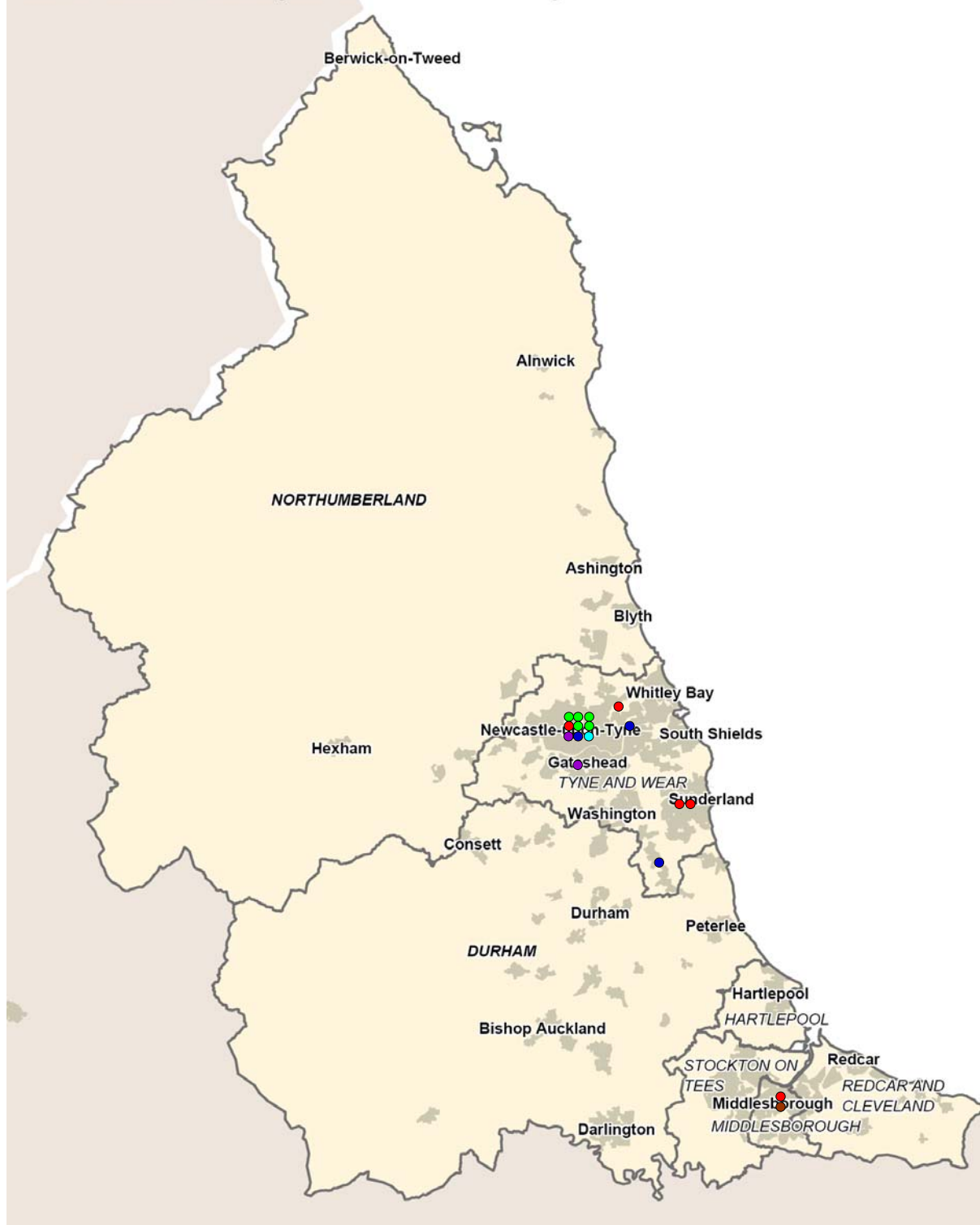

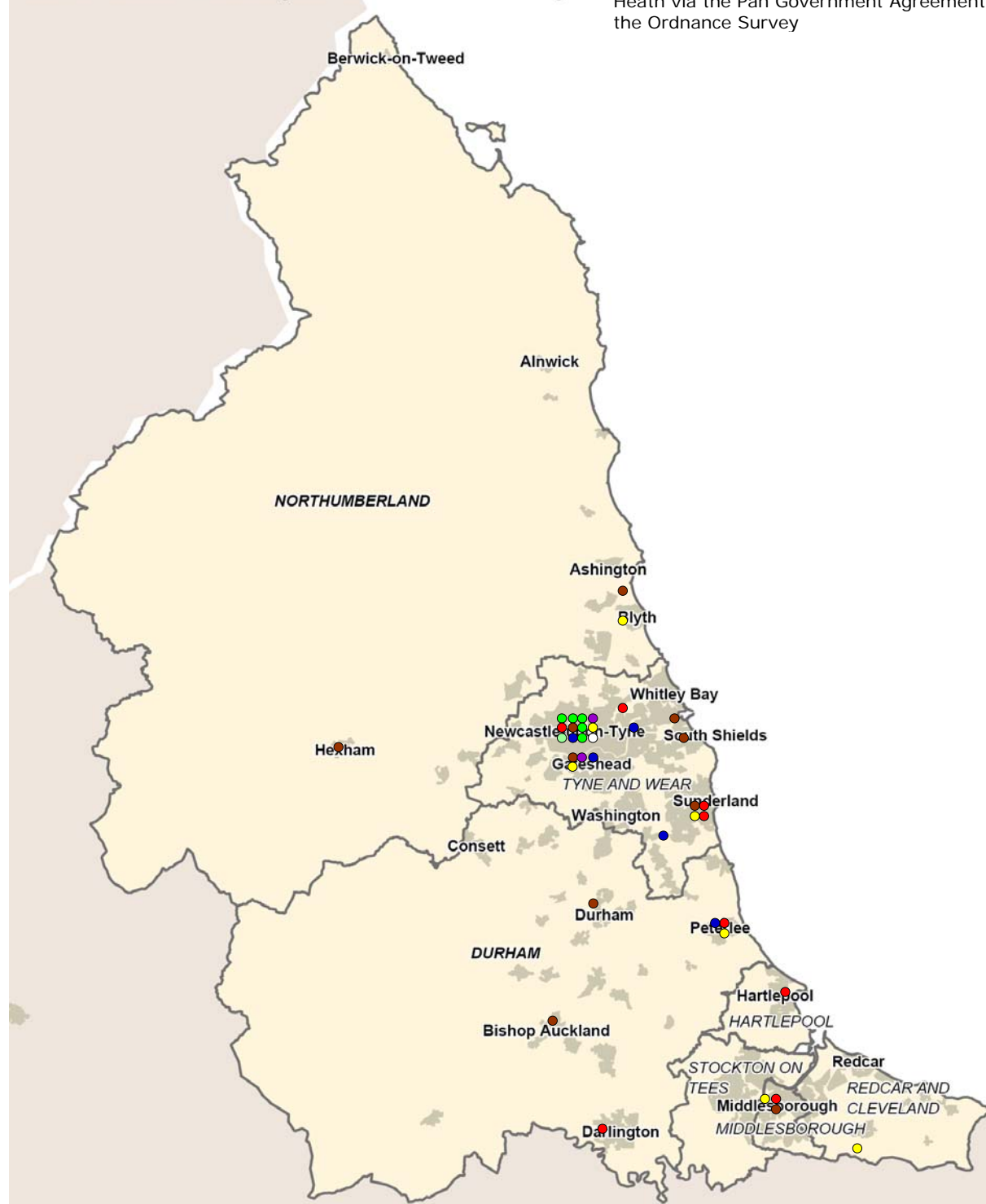
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**Map 13 Specialist services for people with stroke in the North East**

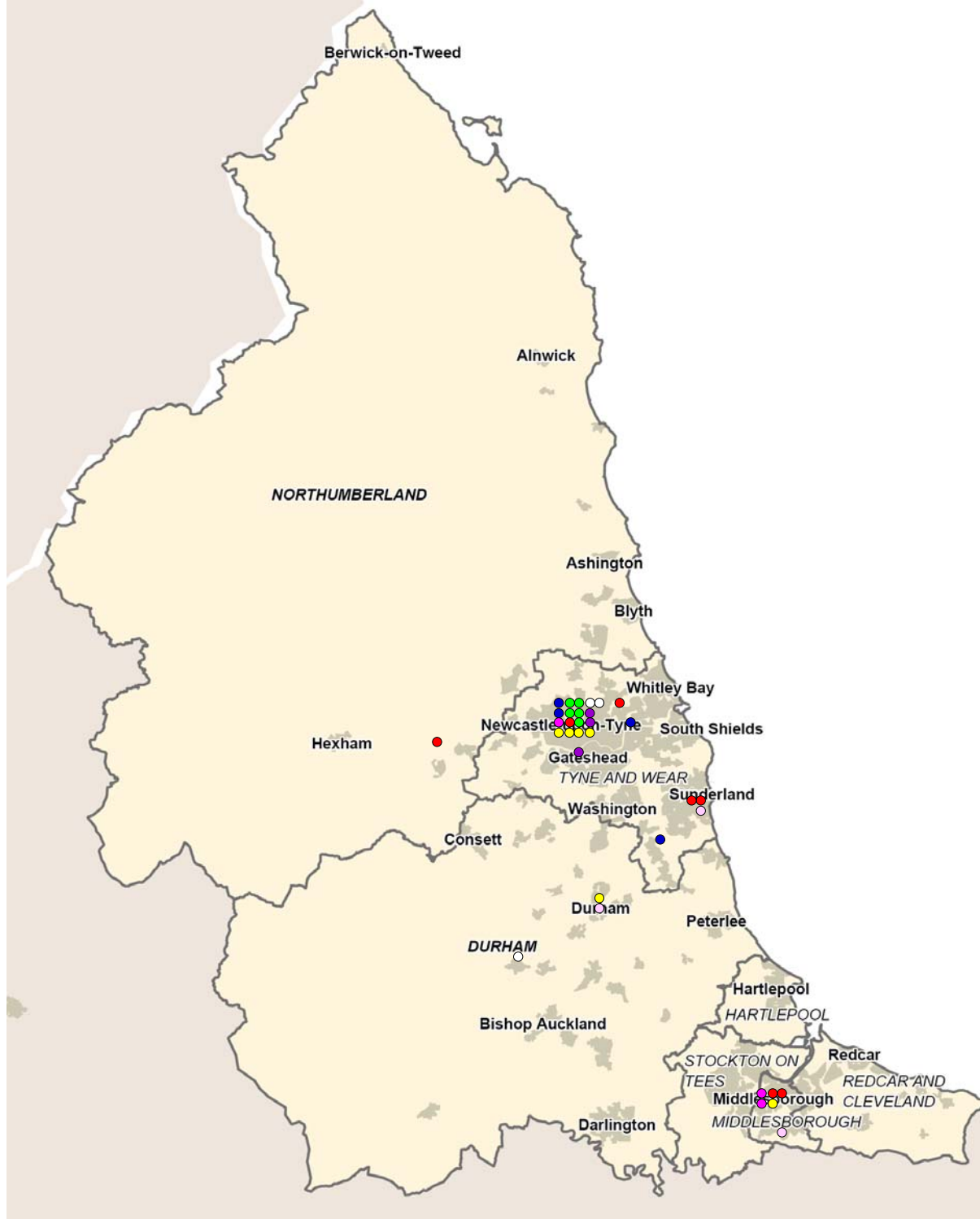

### Map 16 Specialist spinal injuries services in the North West

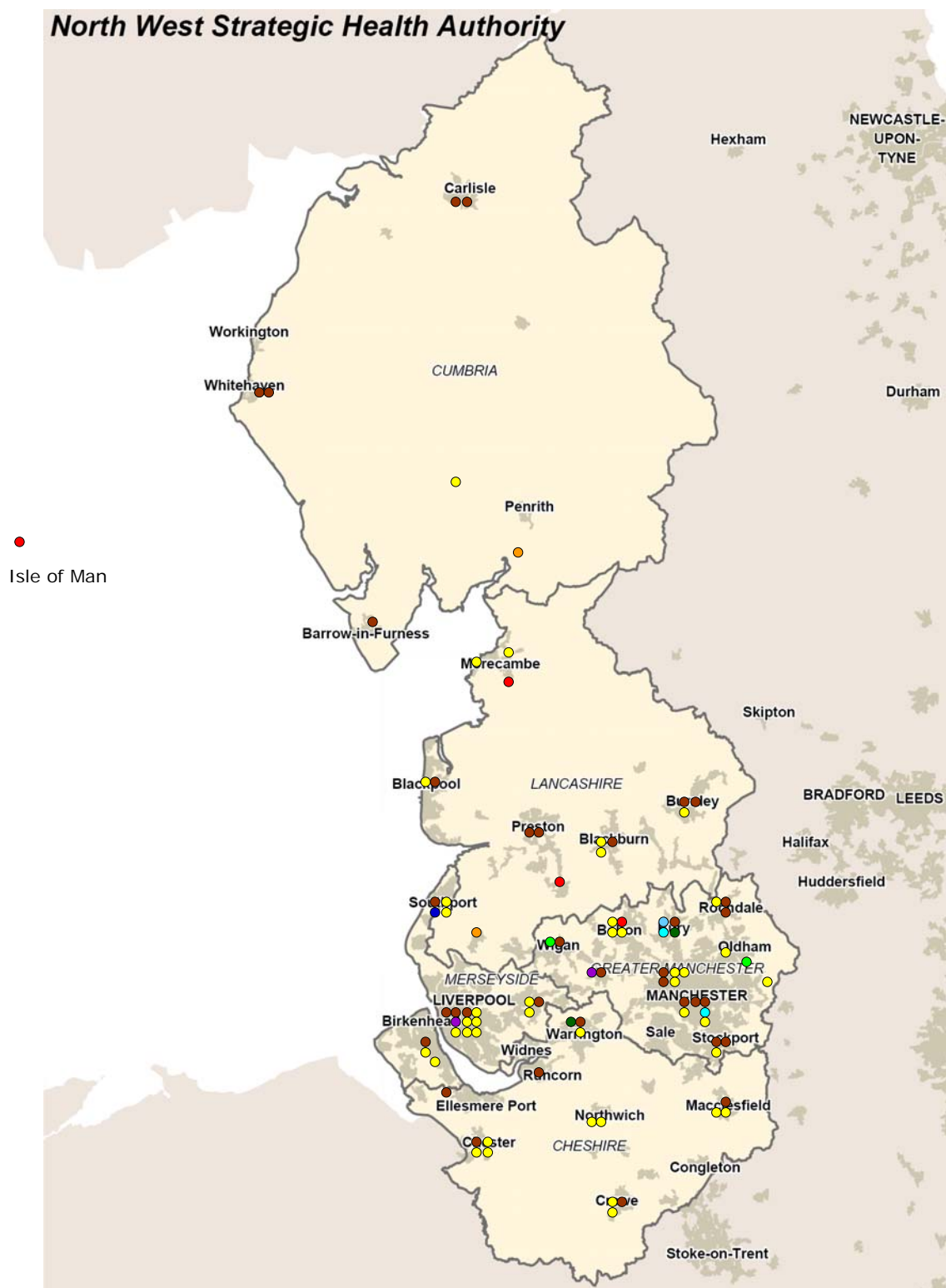

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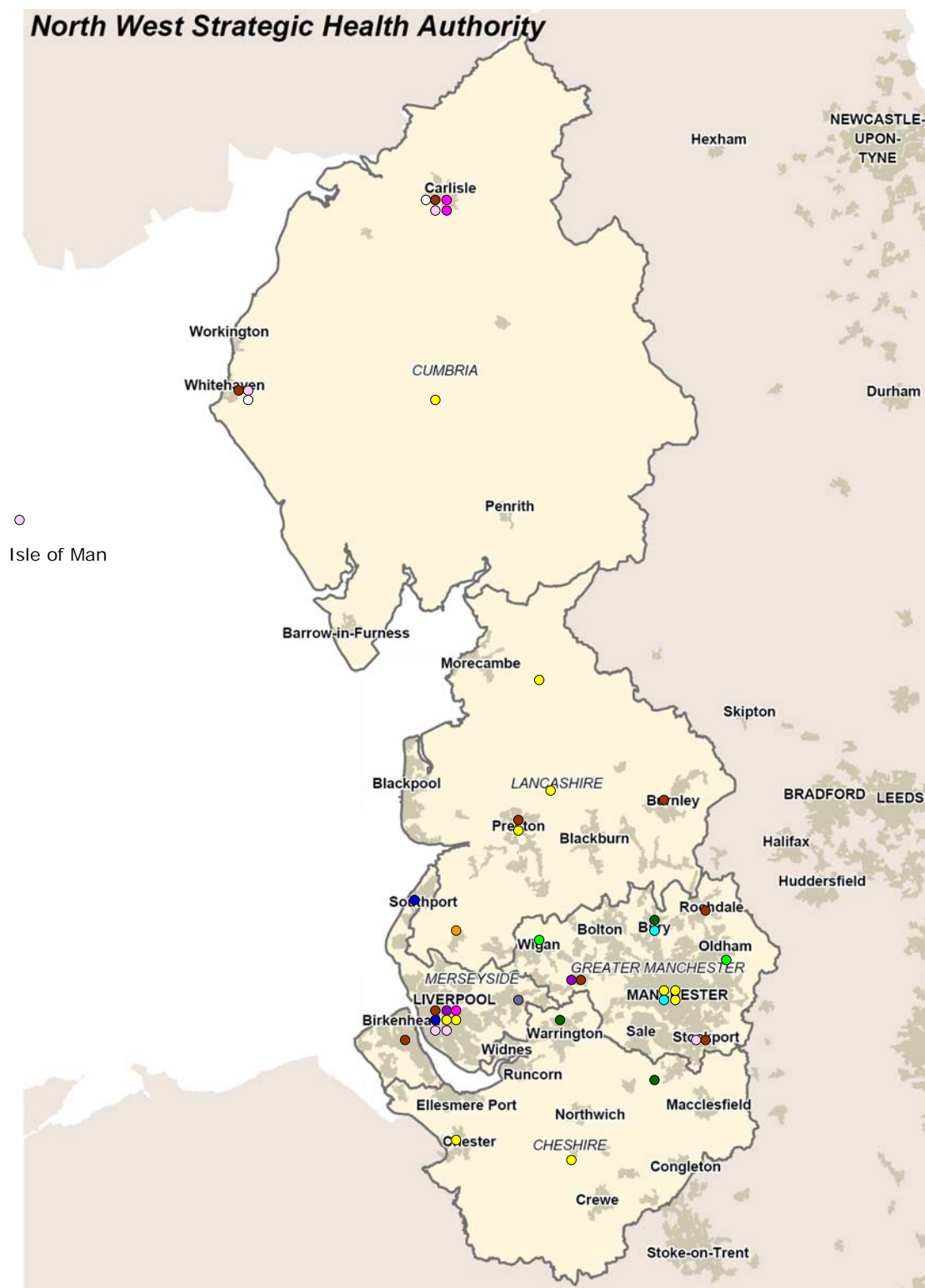
Map 17 Specialist services for stroke in the North West
