Record clots by indicating whether they are approximately 2 centimetres or for larger clots – approximately 3 centimetres

For example: under day 1 you may say that you had 1 clot of approximately 2 centimetres and 3 clots of approximately 3 centimetres - you would write this as 1 x 2cm, 3 x 3cm. Record any incidences of flooding by placing a tick mark in the flooding row under the relevant day.
